

SYSTEM SAFETY POLICY

The safety level of Saab system and products shall meet relevant laws, regulations, international standards and best practices in accordance with the expectations of the society, customers and authorities.

The following principles apply to all our activities:

- all employees at Saab shall understand their role and associated responsibilities in relation to safety of our systems
- all employees at Saab have a common responsibility to maintain system safety by following established working procedures
- Saab shall not take risks that is not accepted by the appointed accountable (approval representative/delegated responsible according to role description)
- anyone who identifies a deficiency has the obligation and responsibility to report the finding to the appointed accountable according to established procedures and routines
- to maintain safe systems, effective procedures for reporting, monitoring and analysis of events, trends and potential system safety risks during the complete product life cycle shall be in place
- time and resources, according to judgement by appointed accountable, shall be allocated to identify and analyse potential system safety risks that may result in accidents or serious incidents and to prevent these as far as possible
- training and information to affected personnel shall be provided.

Definitions

- Safety - Freedom from conditions that can cause death, injury, occupational illness, damage to or loss of equipment or property, or damage to the environment. (MIL-STD-882E).
- System Safety - The application of engineering and management principles, criteria, and techniques to achieve acceptable risk within the constraints of operational effectiveness and suitability, time, and cost throughout all phases of the system life-cycle. (MIL-STD-882E).
- Systems can consists of subsystems, products and services.
