Saab's new navigation system approved for the Panama Canal

Saab's latest maritime navigation system, R6 NAV NEO, has received approval from the Panama Canal Authority. This makes it the first SOLAS* approved navigation system for general use in any waters which also meets the new requirements for Panama Canal transits.
