Saab to divest TransponderTech

Saab today announces the divestment of Saab TransponderTech AB to Teledyne Technologies Inc.'s Swedish subsidiary, FLIR Systems AB. Completion of the divestment is subject to certain conditions that are expected to be fulfilled by the end of Q4 2025.

TransponderTech is a leader in Safety Of Life At Sea (SOLAS)-certified communications and navigation solutions for commercial maritime, military, and airborne applications. The divestment is in line with Saab's strategy to increase its focus on core areas of its business and, upon closing, Saab will divest 100 percent of its shares in Saab TransponderTech AB.

"Transpondertech is an outstanding and innovative company, and we are proud of its achievements. As we strategically focus on expanding within the military segments, we believe that TransponderTech will find even greater opportunities for growth and success within Teledyne Technologies. This decision aligns with our strategic goals and is intended to provide TransponderTech with the best possible conditions to move forward," says Carl-Johan Bergholm, head of Saab's business area Surveillance.
