

Multiple mission types require a flexible approach to on board medical services.

Saab's flexible approach lets you choose the medical services and features that best suit your navy's needs and the intended role of each vessel.

A basic set-up might include a trauma unit and ward wing. Additional facilities can be added, such as an operating theatre, intensive care units and triage and resuscitation facilities to bring a vessel's level of trauma care on par with an established land-based hospital. More comprehensive care options that can be added include a pressure chamber, oxygen generation, dental care facilities, a pharmacy and a medical lab.

Having a stable platform in which medical staff can work is crucial to delivering care.

Saab works closely with shipbuilders and end customers to design hospital solutions that mitigate the challenges of rough seas through the use of support structures. This collaborative approach to design also delivers a customised fit-for-purpose patient flow.
